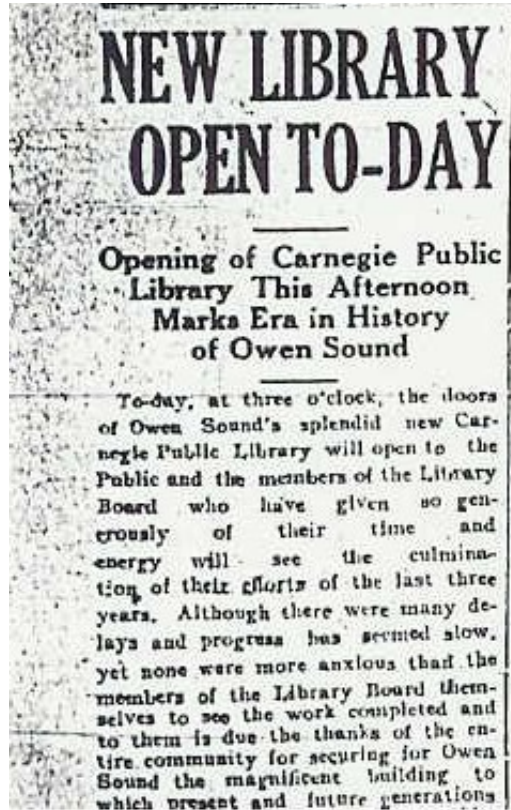
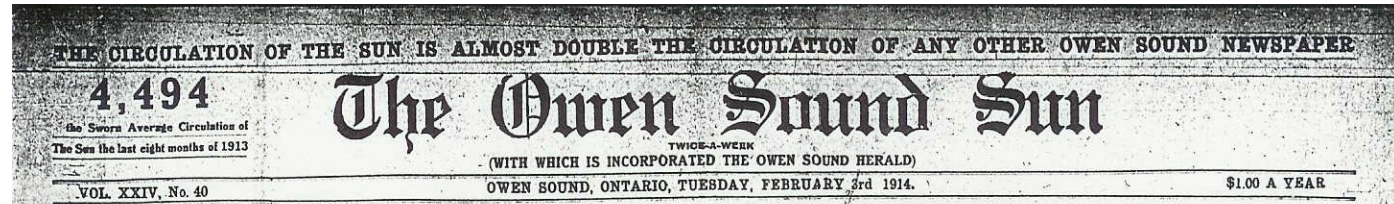


Library History: 1855 – Mechanics Institute

On October 10, 1855, one hundred and two citizens signed a Charter to establish a Mechanics' Institute and Library Association at the Town of Sydenham (which officially became Owen Sound in 1857).

McNie praises library at official opening

Initiative of the community has placed Owen Sound's library in the forefront of such facilities in Ontario, Jack McNie, provincial minister of colleges and universities, said Monday at the official opening of the city's new library addition and the renovated older section.

"This centre for providing culture and entertainment is

part of Ontario's 'new thrust' in government to make the best use of resources we have in every field," Mr. McNie said.

The minister said the new policy is indicated in the higher priority being placed on library expansion and higher library grants being awarded in the province. He said that at a library conference

in November discussion will be held on the possible wide future role libraries will play in the lives of citizens.

Pointing out that Owen Sound library is one of the three main resource centres in Georgian Bay region, Mr. McNie said it has been fortunate in the type of board members and employees which have developed the facilities for the entire district.

Commenting on the new library building, Mr. McNie said, "There doesn't seem to be any limit to the innovations possible with this new Owen Sound library."

Cutting of the ribbon, on the landing of stairs between the old and new portions of the library, by Mr. McNie, assisted by board chairman W. A. Belrose, signified the opening of the new building.

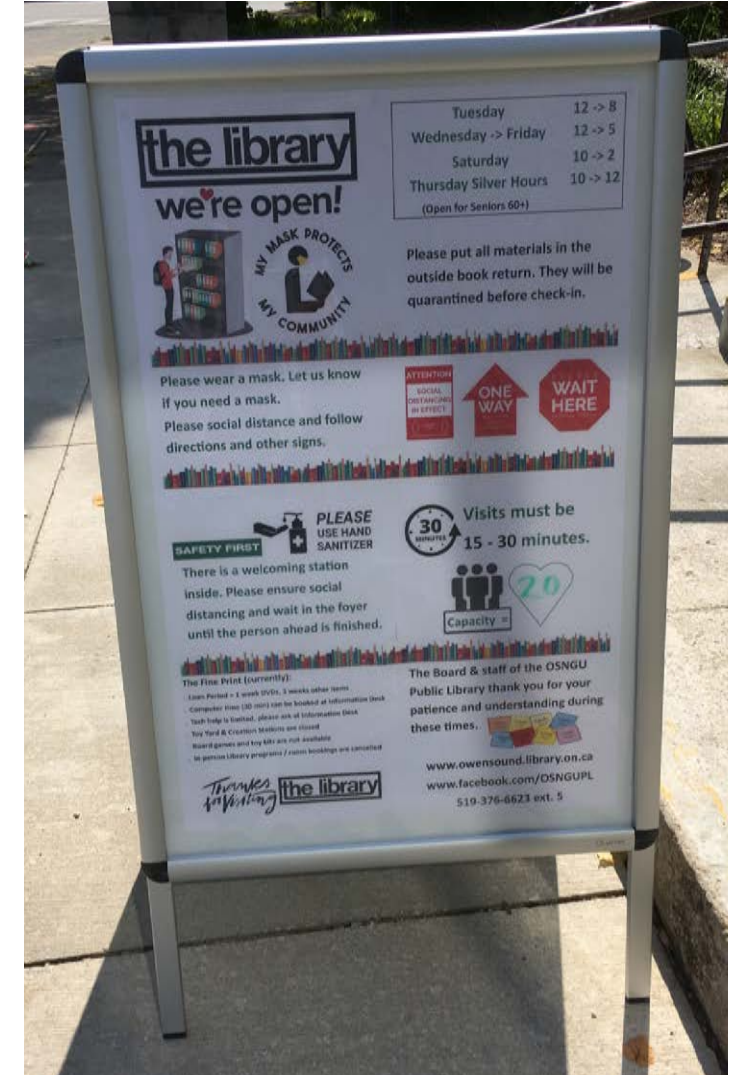

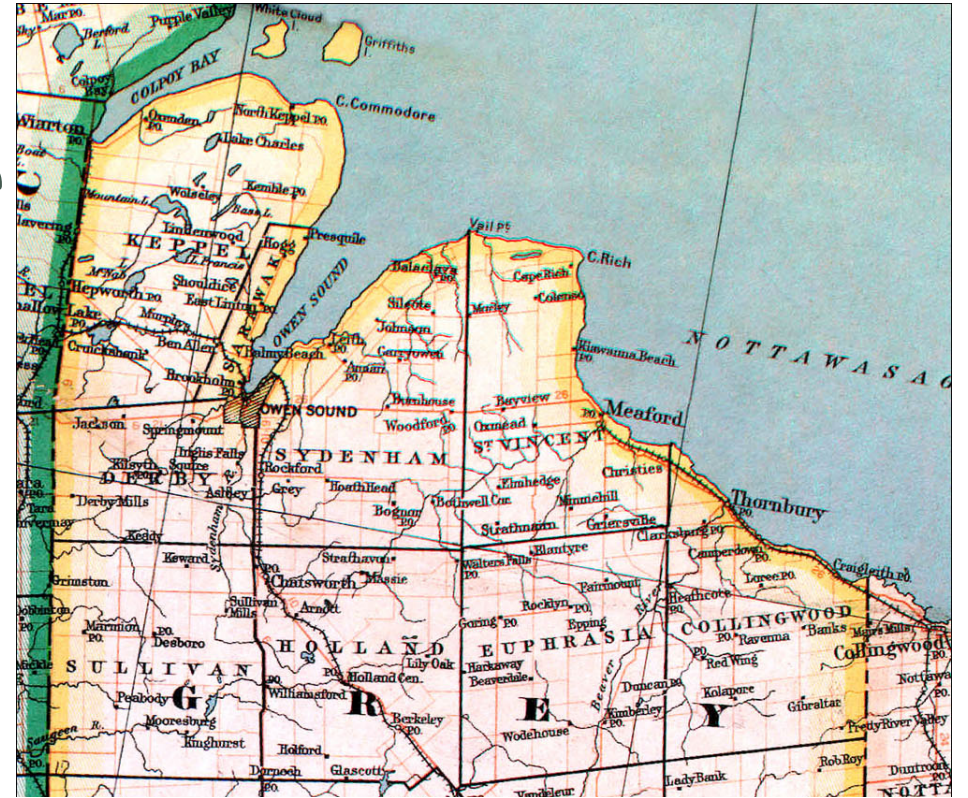

Library History: 1994 Birth of the Union Library

The former Townships of Derby, Keppel, Sarawak, Sydenham and the Villages of Chatsworth and Shallow Lake, and the City of Owen Sound were founding members of the Owen Sound & North Grey Union Public Library Board in 1994.



By 1995, the former Townships of Holland and Sullivan had joined the Union Library.

Library History: Union Library Agreement

Establishment of union public library

5 (1) The councils of two or more municipalities may make an agreement for the establishment of a union public library. R.S.O. 1990, c. P.44, s. 5 (1).

Agreement

(2) An agreement under subsection (1) shall specify what proportion of the cost of the establishment, operation and maintenance of the union public library, including the cost of existing libraries, shall be paid by each municipality. R.S.O. 1990, c. P.44, s. 5 (2).

Union board

(3) A union public library shall be under the management and control of a union board, which is a corporation known in English as The *(insert appropriate name)* Union Public Library Board and in French as Conseil de la bibliothèque publique unie de *(insert appropriate name)*. R.S.O. 1990, c. P.44, s. 5 (3).

1994 – 2001: First Union Library Agreement

2002 – 2011: Full funding achieved by 2008

2012 – 2021: Signed by Municipality of Meaford

2018: Separate agreement with Meaford Public Library

2022 – 2031: Agreement based on historic usage patterns

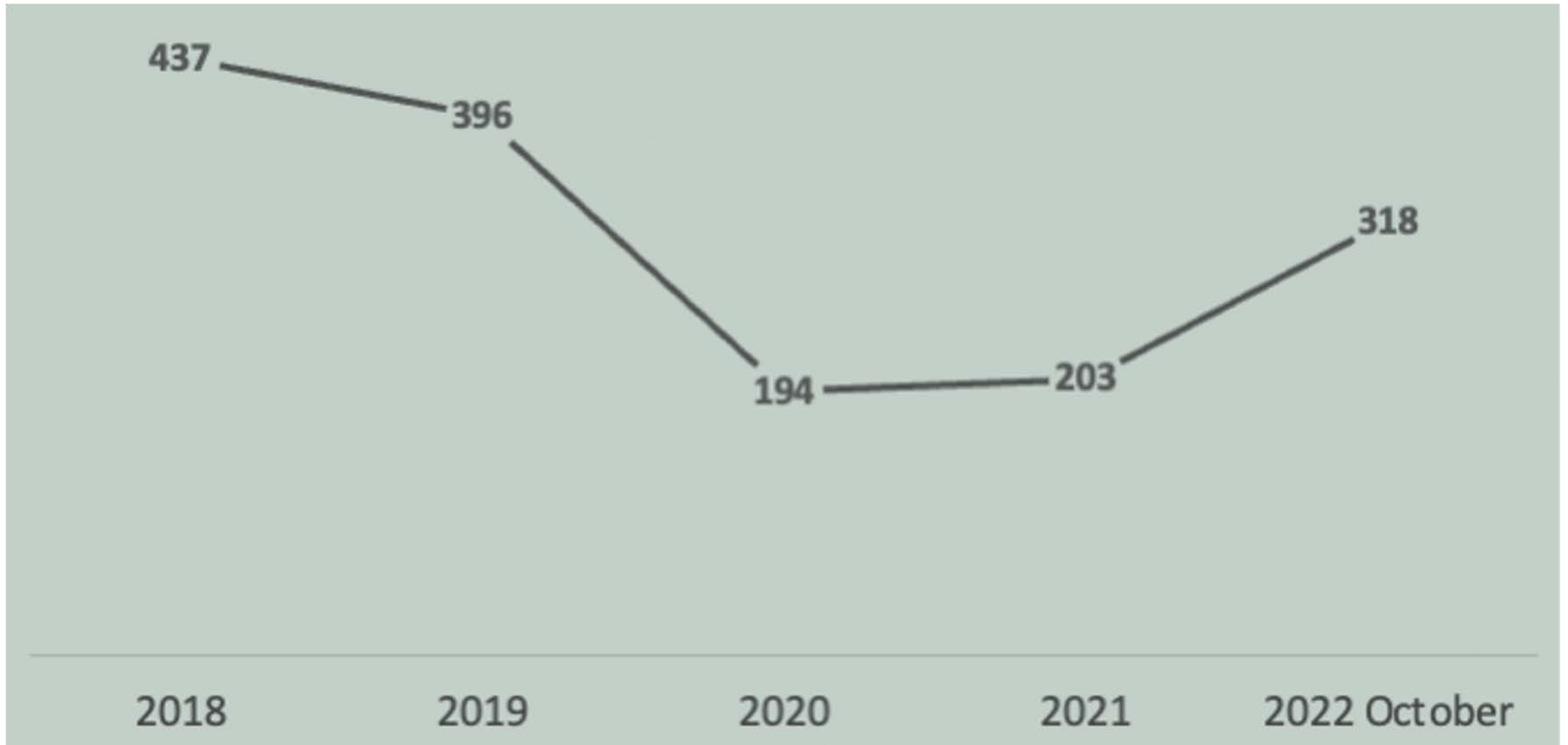
Library Service Index - Visits



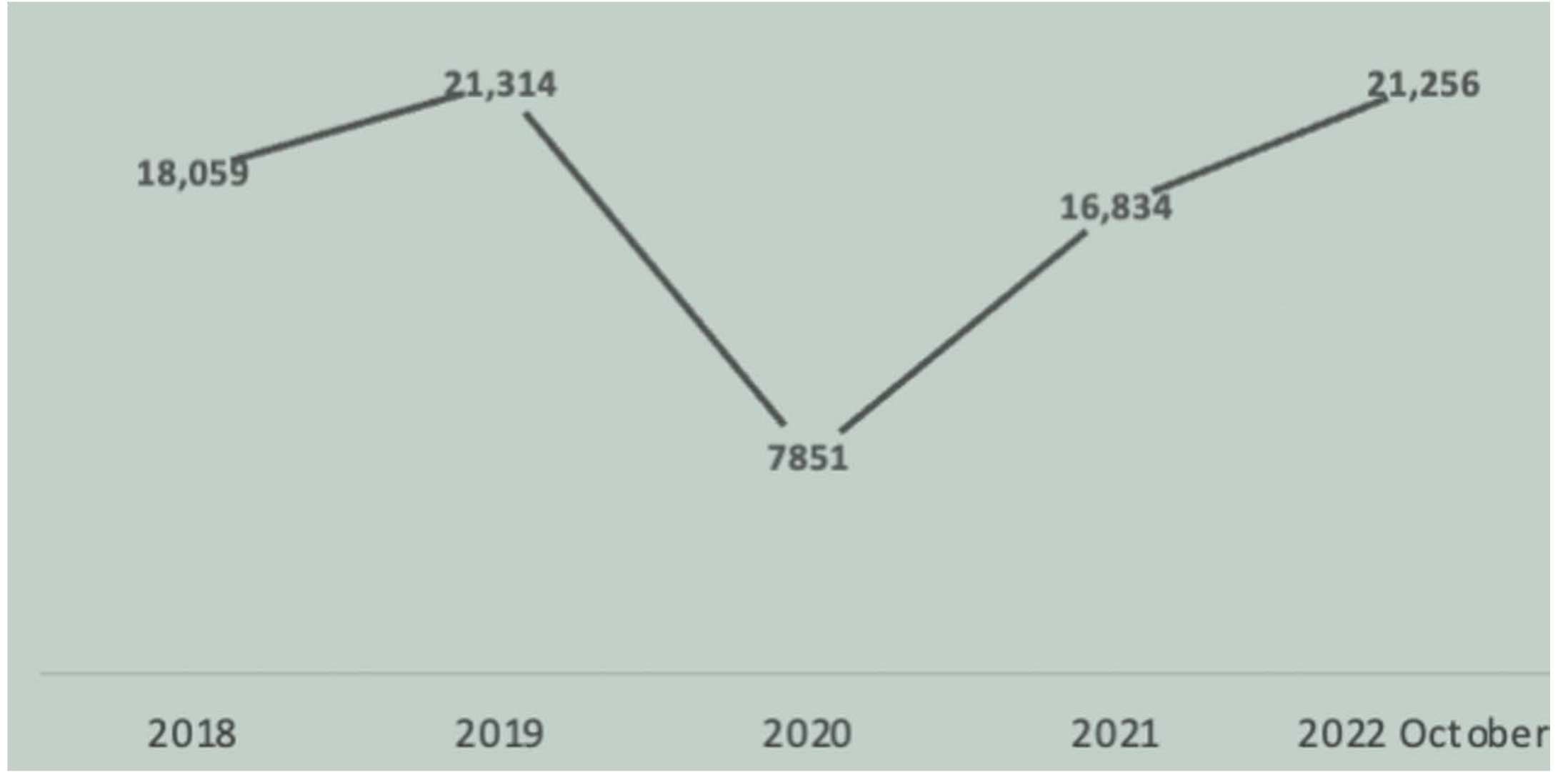
Library Service Index – Materials Borrowed



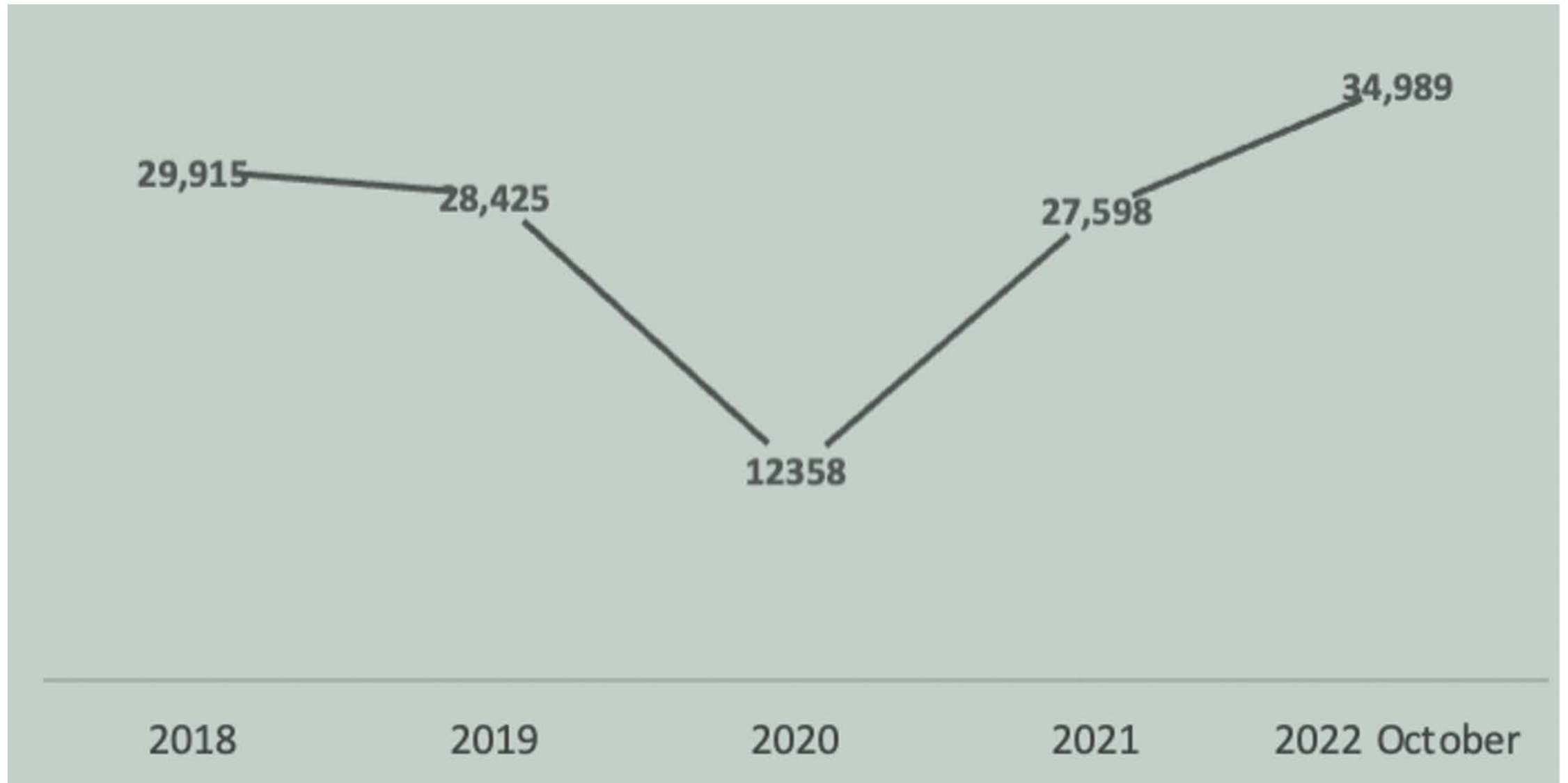
