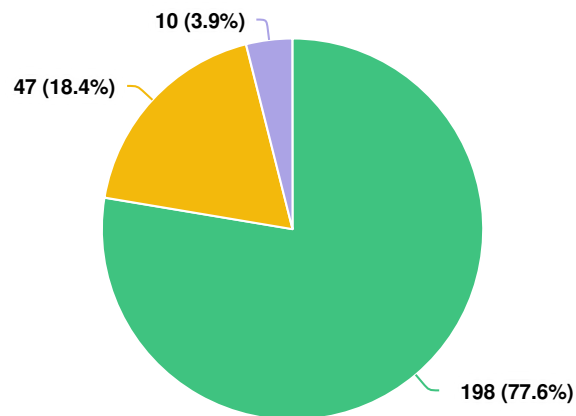

Q1 | Are you a current resident of Georgian Bluffs?

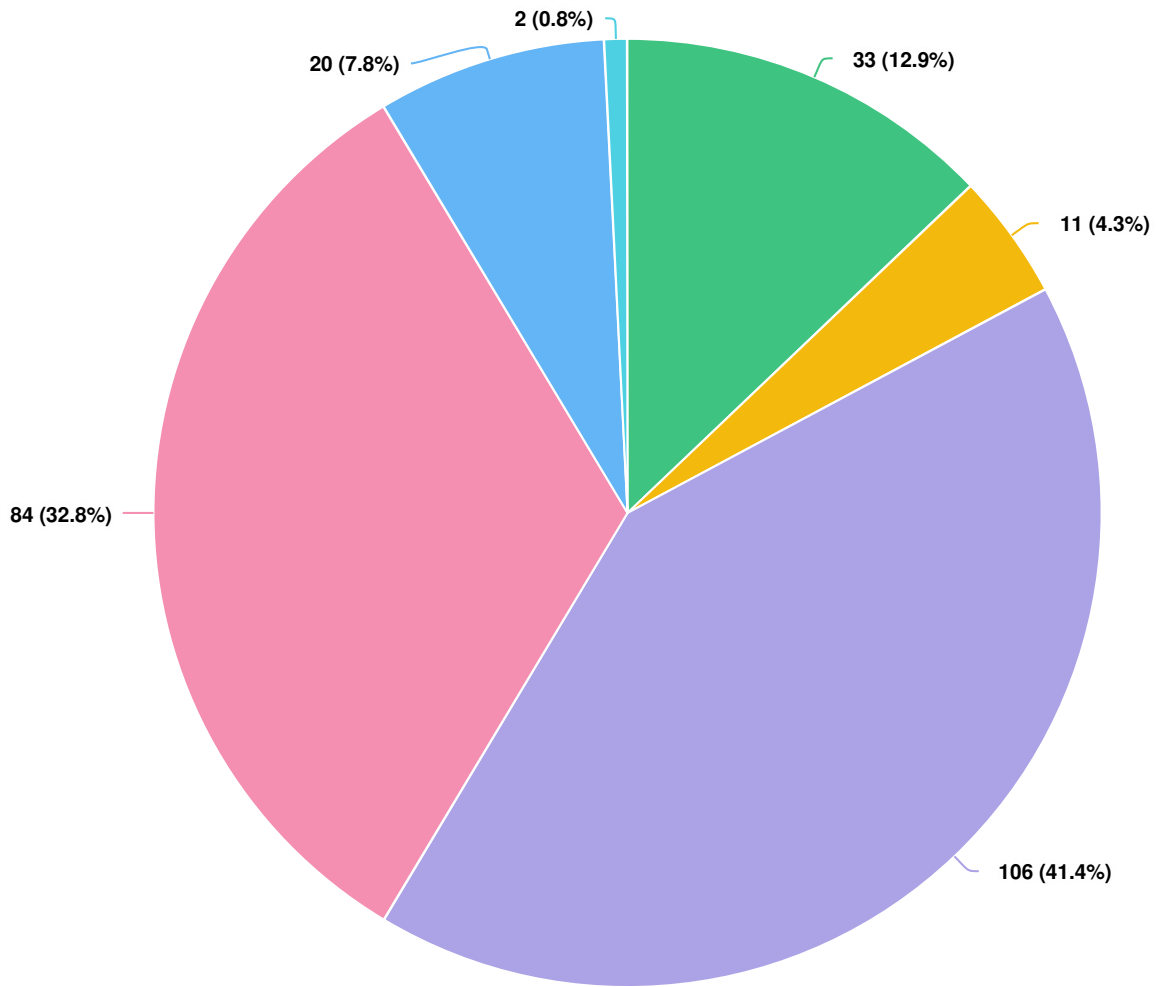

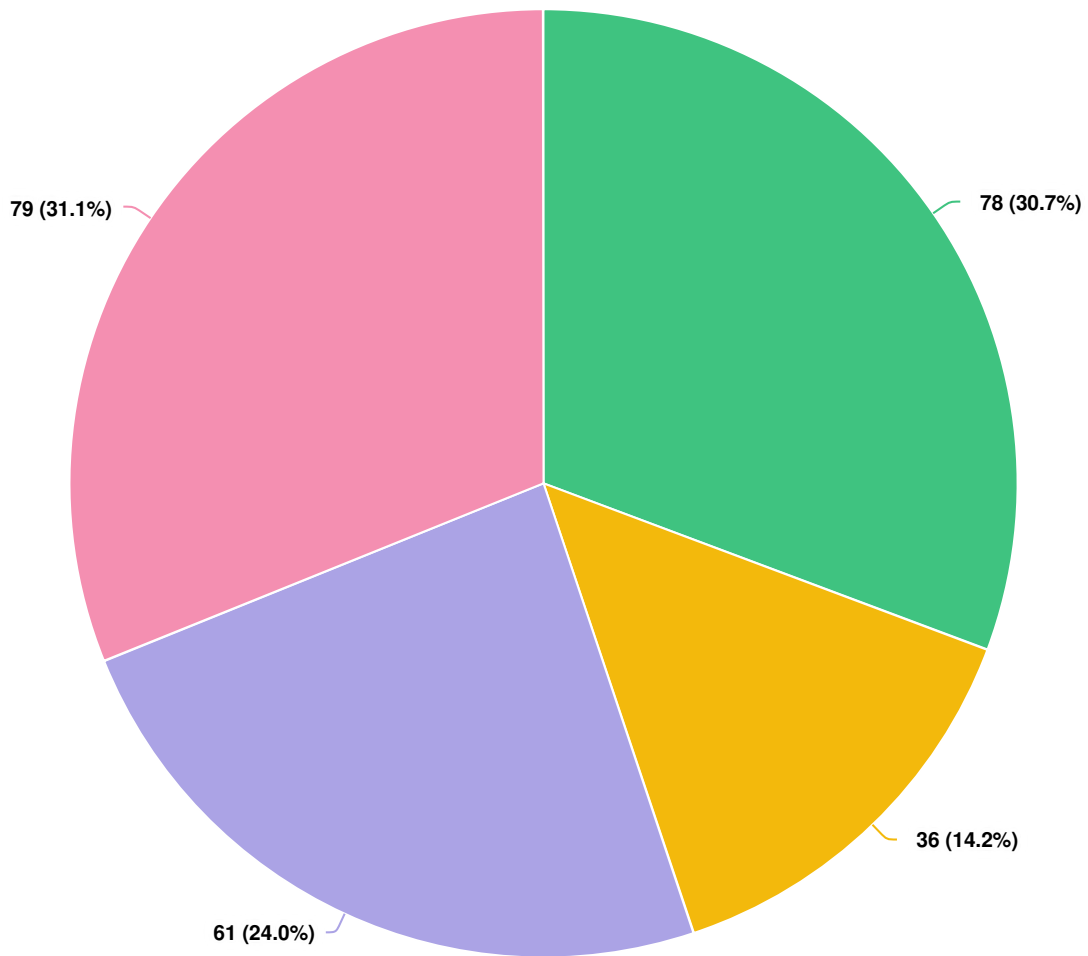

Q3 Does your household want to keep backyard chickens?

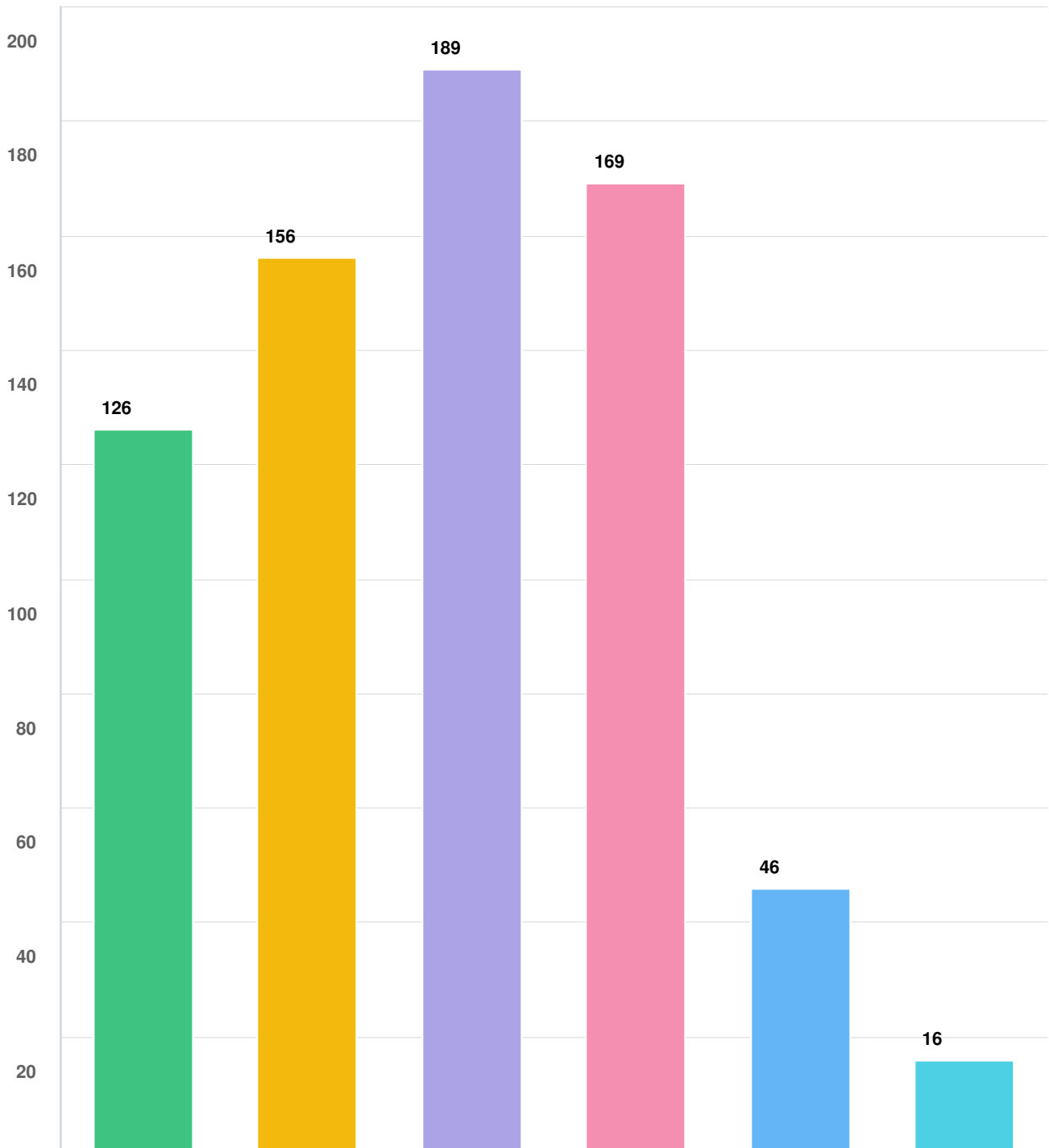

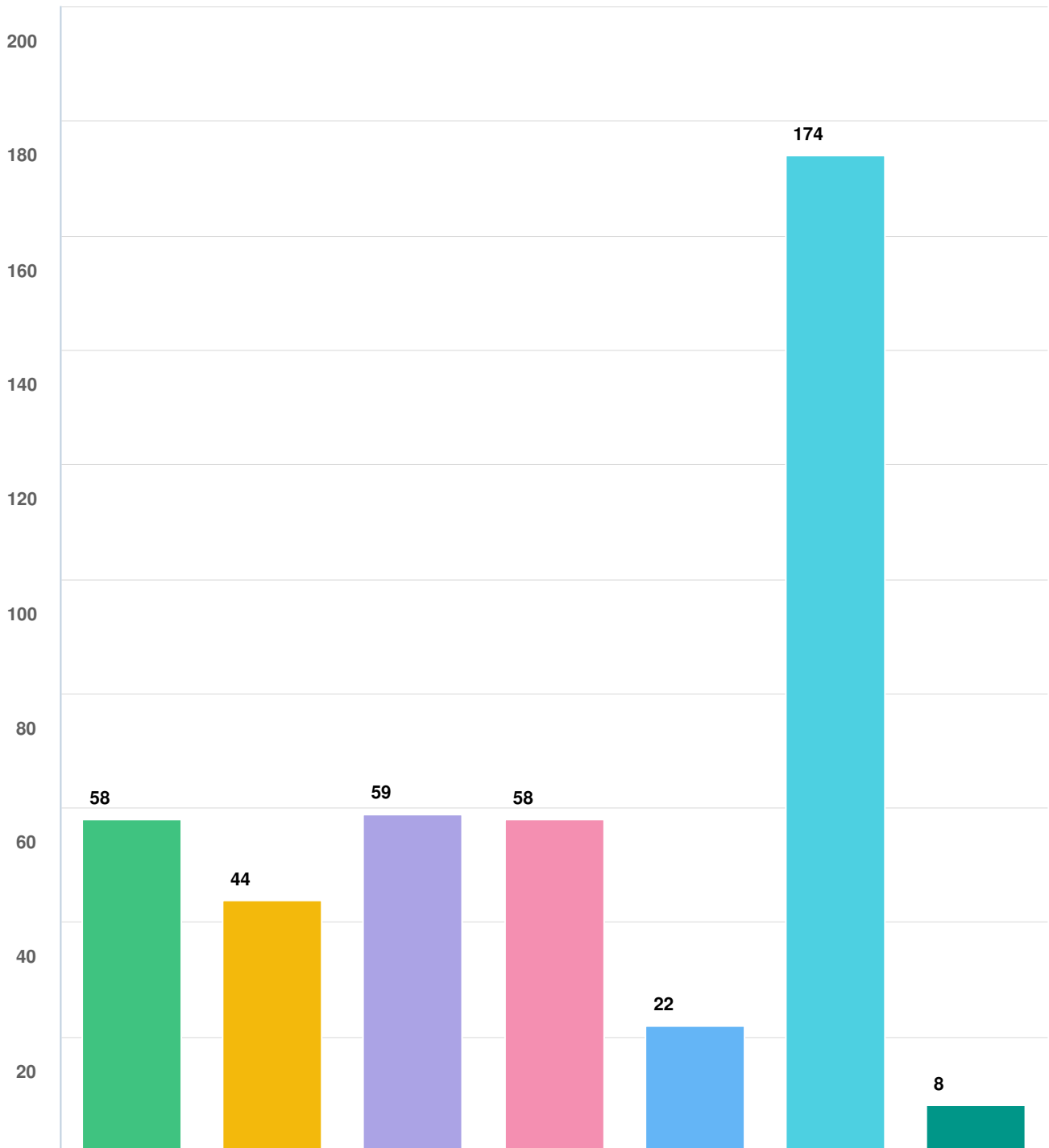

Q5 Why do you think backyard chickens should not be allowed in all areas of Georgian Bluffs? Please check all that apply.

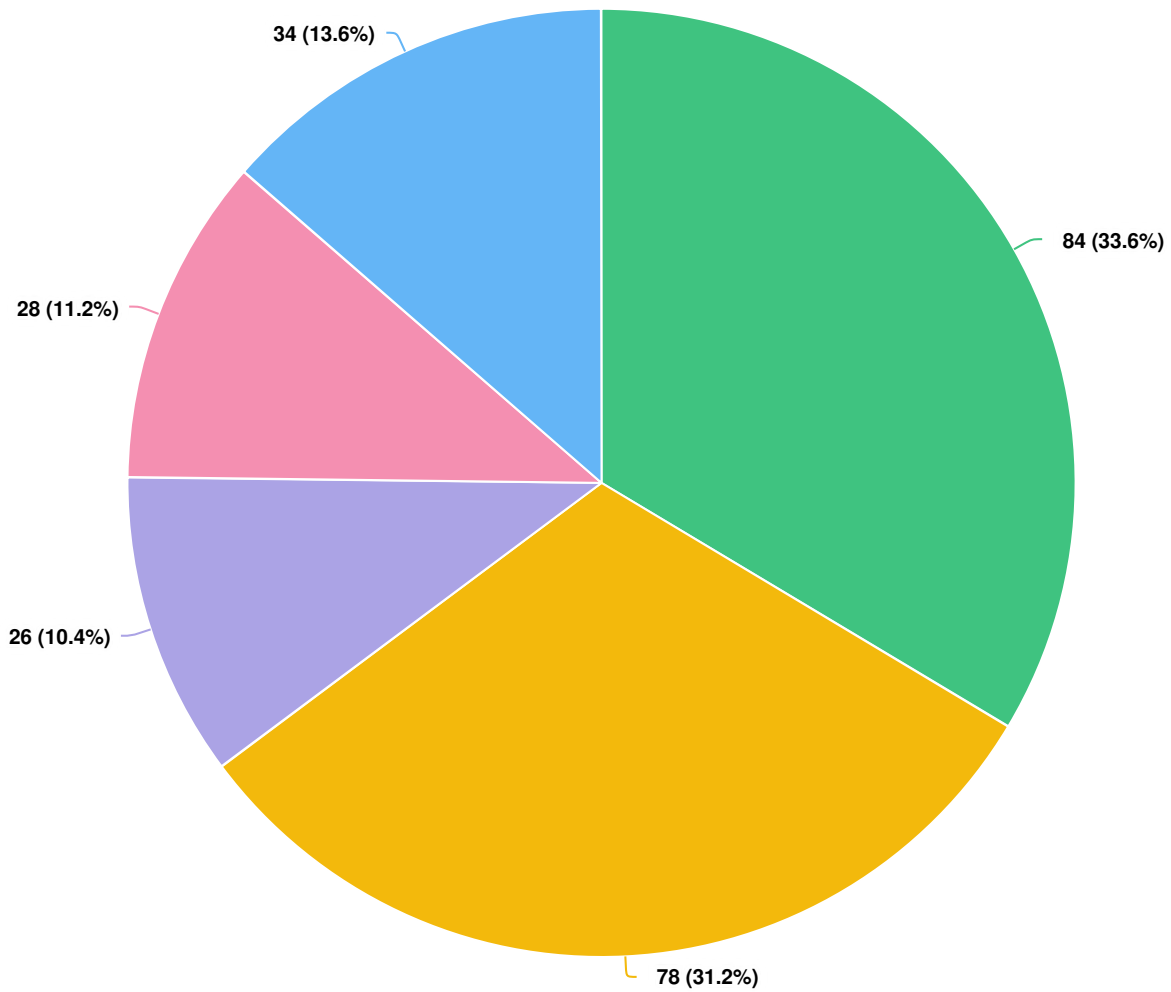

Q6 What is the minimum property size you feel would be appropriate for backyard chickens?

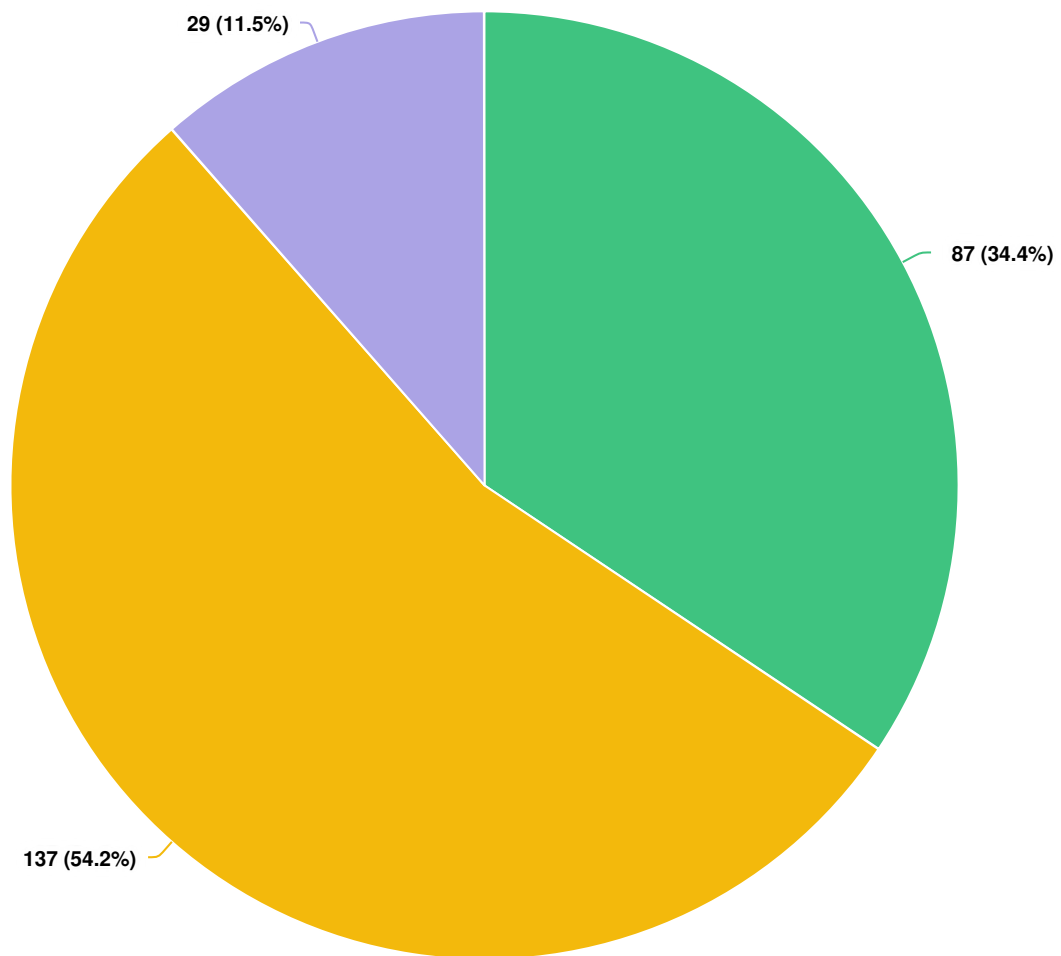

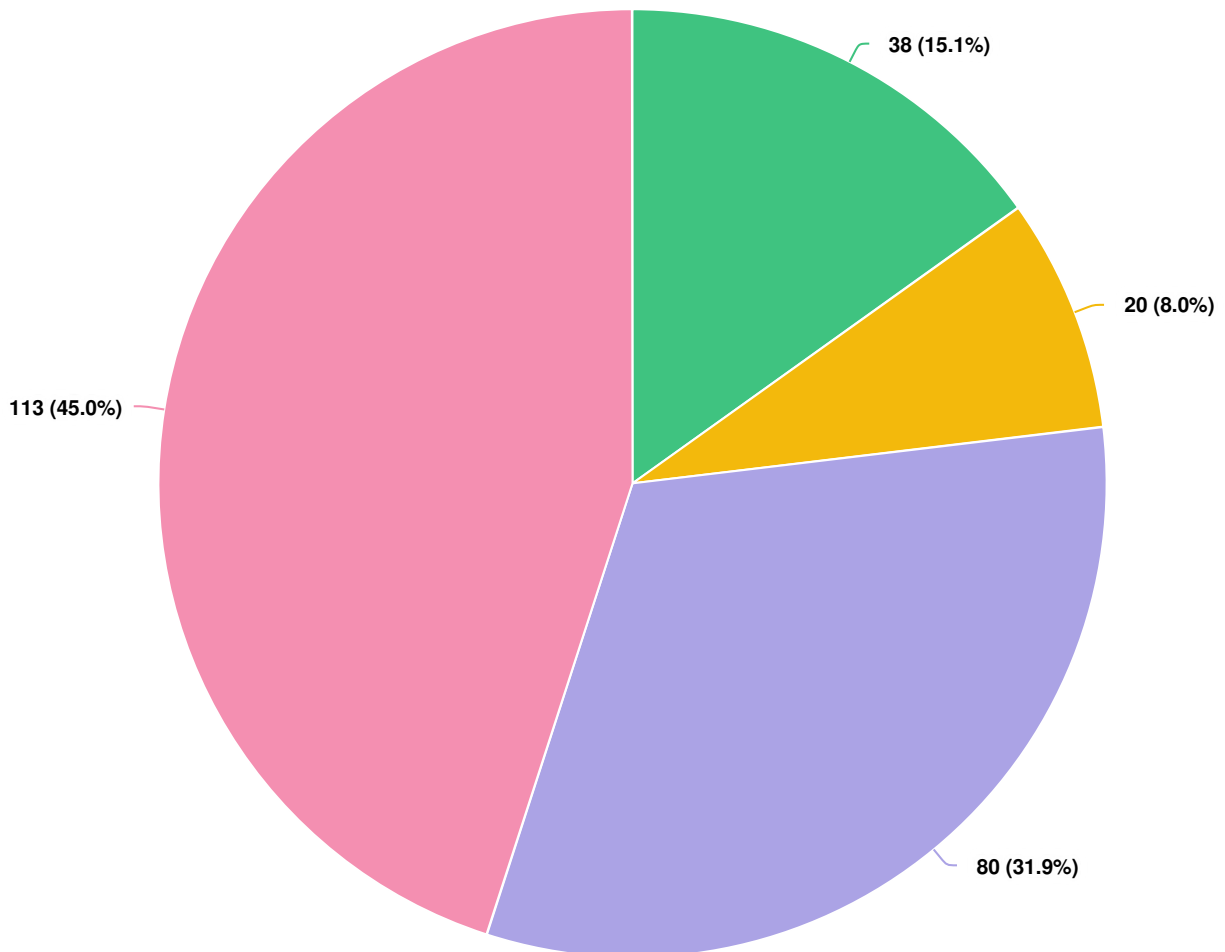
